IED Venezia is taking part in 'Art Night Venezia. Art frees the night 2012' with an architectural mapping video that will liven up the facade of Palazzo Franchetti on the Grand Canal, the new Venetian offices of the IED (European Design Institute) from 1 June.

'The light of art frees creativity' is the theme of this sound and light performance created with the innovative 'mapping' technique, which uses an architectural space, giving it perspective and movement.

The play of lights, projections and animations can be admired on the side facade of Palazzo Franchetti six times on Saturday 23 June, from 9.30 pm and then every 30 minutes.

It is being produced by Mery Glez, from the KLADD Design matters studio (<u>www.kladdonline.com</u>), a former student at the IED.

Giudecca 795 Art Gallery - Palazzo Loredan Cyber Venezia 23 June 2012, from 8 pm to 10 pm

The Giudecca 795 Art Gallery continues its association with the Istituto Veneto di Scienze, Lettere ed Arti presenting 'Cyber Venezia' at Palazzo Loredan, a project recently launched with the artist Neil Harbisson, and one of his 'cyber-art' performances. Harbisson, who sees the world in black and white due to a genetic condition, is internationally known for his Eyeborg, an instrument that allows him to 'listen to colours'. In 2011 he presented his 'sound portraits' at Palazzo Franchetti; now he has started 'painting Venice in sound', exploring the city with patience, respect and artistic and scientific curiosity, starting from the brightly coloured houses on the island of Burano, with very exciting results.

The project will be illustrated with a video and an interactive demonstration of sound, colour and dance at Palazzo Loredan from 8 pm to 10 pm. It will also be possible to have a personal sound portrait made, by reservation and depending on availability of time.

On the occasion of 'Art Night Venezia', the Giudecca 795 Art Gallery on Fondamenta San Biagio will remain open to the public until midnight.
