

The Istituto Veneto's International Journalism Award for Venice 2020-2021 edition

The Award aims to acknowledge an article or brief essay on Venice, that stands out for its acute analysis of the city's reality and its ability to grasp its multifaceted social, economic, natural or artistic aspects.

The €. 10,000 prize money will be awarded by a Committee, that includes the Istituto's Governing Board and five judges identified by the latter.

Articles, reports or essays that fulfil the scope of the Award can be submitted to the Committee in their original version or as a link, with the indication of where and when they were published, by the editors or the authors, or by Associations, Entities or Cultural Institutions. The material required, together with a brief biography/curriculum of author/s must be submitted to the Judging (cancelleria@istitutoveneto.it) of Istituto Veneto di Scienze, Lettere ed Arti (Campo Santo Stefano, 2945 – 30124 Venezia), by registered mail or by e-mail, stating in the subject line "Premio dell'Istituto Veneto per Venezia", no later than 15 February 2021. The works submitted must have been published in 2019-2020. Articles published in languages other than Italian, English, French, German or Spanish must be sent with a translation into any of these five languages.

The awarding ceremony will take place on the occasion of the Solemn Meeting celebrating the end of the 2020-2021 Academic Year.

By accepting the Award, the author/s accept/s to hold a public conference in the Istituto on the work awarded, free of charge, and according to the terms and dates to be agreed with the Chancellor's Office.

The Members of the Istituto Veneto may not apply for the award.
