

The Istituto Veneto's International Journalism Prize for Venice

2014 edition

The Prize will reward a press article or a video report on Venice that stands out for its acute understanding of the multifaceted social, economic, natural or artistic aspects of the Venetian situation.

The Prize (€ 5,000) will be presented by a Committee to be appointed by the Istituto Veneto's Governing Board. The Judging Committee for the 2013 edition of the Prize will include the Institute's Governing Board and the Members Lady Frances Clarke, Leopoldo Mazzarolli, Antonio Paolucci, Pierre Rosenberg, Wolfgang Wolters and Alvisè Zorzi.

The emeritus Chancellor of the Institute, Sandro Franchini, is appointed Secretary of the Committee.

Indications of articles or video reports which fulfil the purpose of the Prize can be sent to the Committee by the Editorial Office of respective newspapers or magazines, by the authors themselves and by Associations, Institutions or other Organizations concerned. The article or dvd of the report, an accompanying letter providing details of where and when it was published and, for articles, if possible an original copy of the newspaper or magazine in which it appeared, together with a brief biography/curriculum vitae of the author must be sent to the Secretariat of the Istituto Veneto di Scienze, Lettere ed Arti (San Marco 2945, I - 30124 Venezia) by registered mail no later than **16th June 2014**.

The articles or video reports submitted must have been published or broadcast between 2012 and 2014.

Articles published in languages other than Italian, English, French, German or Spanish must be sent with a translation into any of these five languages.

The Prize will be awarded at the seat of the Istituto Veneto on Sunday 28th September 2014.
